There is a range of membership packages for students, younger members, individuals, and larger organisations. CIGRE membership is open to all individuals, companies and organisations across five categories:

Collective member I

Public or private companies, including power system transmission and distribution utilities, scientific and technical organisations, research Institutes and administrative bodies.

Universities and other educational bodies

Costs

Membership costs vary by country. They start from €42 for individuals under 35, through to Collective membership rates of €280 a year for a Collective member II (e.g. university). Your costs will be provided for your approval before your membership application is finalised.

Applications can be made directly via the directory or click and complete the form relevant to your desired membership category. Your application will then be forwarded to your local NC or handled by CIGRE Central Office.
