- Big data used for detecting cyber anomalies in electric power utility informational and operational technology (IT/OT).

PS 3: New internet of things (IoT) application to support electric power utilities

- 5G for utility networks;
- · New internet of things applications to support electric power utilities;
- \cdot Cybersecurity issues in internet of things.



SUBMISSION

Authors are invited to submit a synopsis (300–500 words, in English) via the online system at: https://www.dropbox.com/request/yv0NwoNPF3ImVUDgJVJY or by e-mail to the Organising Committee by September 30, 2018. The submitted synopses will go through a peer review processs. The notification of acceptance is October 26, 2018. Upon synopsis acceptance, a 6 to 8 page paper in CIGRE format should be submitted for the final contribution by January 31, 2019 via the same online system as the synopses.

Accepted final contributions will be included in the conference proceedings and papers will be published in the online CIGRE library (*www.e-cigre.org*), provided the contributions are fully registered by at least one author and presented in person at the colloquium.
